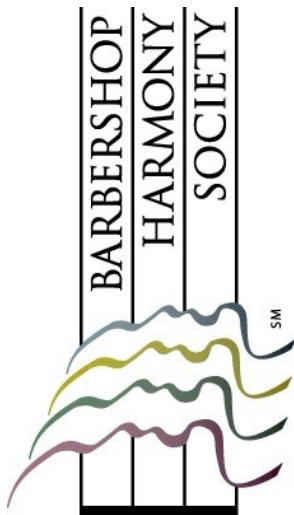

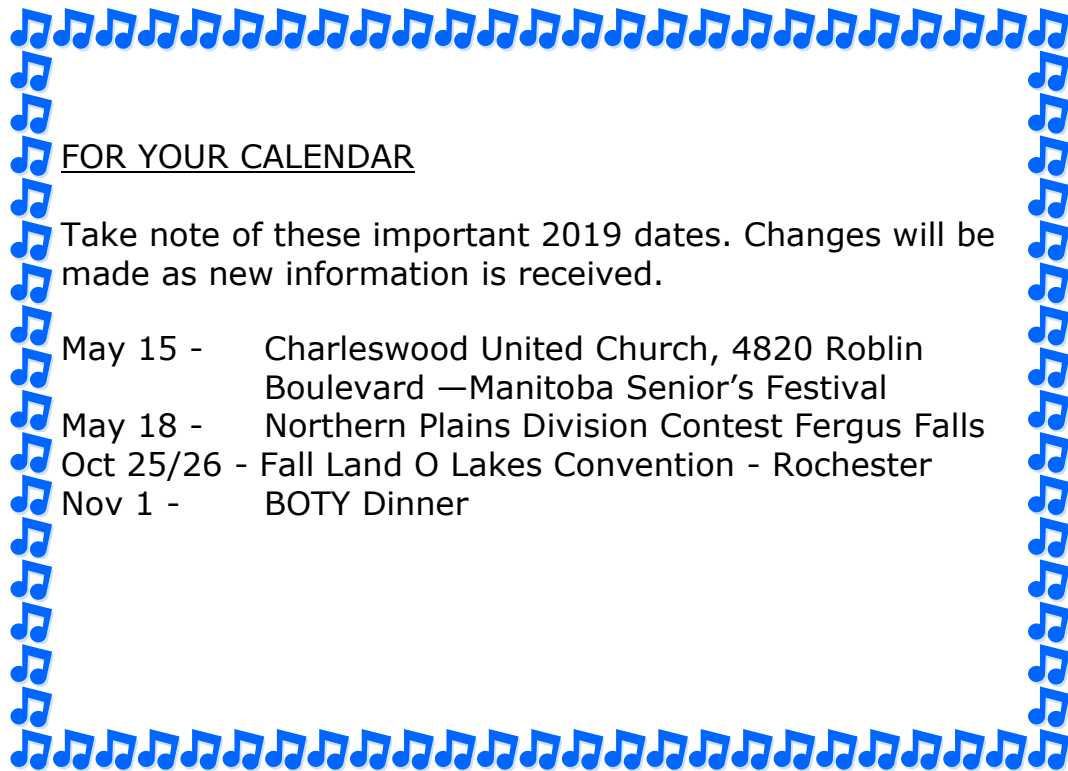

Your chapter and member donations to Sing Canada Harmony allowed us to provide almost \$90,000 in **vocal music education scholarships** in 2018. Some of the BHS, SAI and HI scholarship recipients were from Dauphin, Brandon, Regina, Saskatoon, Winnipeg, and Thunder Bay. Other recipients included two Winnipeg schools (Daniel MacIntyre and West Kildonan Collegiate), Winkler Senior's Chorus, Winkler's Douglas Kuhl School of Music and about 50 individuals from across Canada, most of whom attended the BHS Harmony University last summer. Thank you for providing support for vocal music education across Canada!
