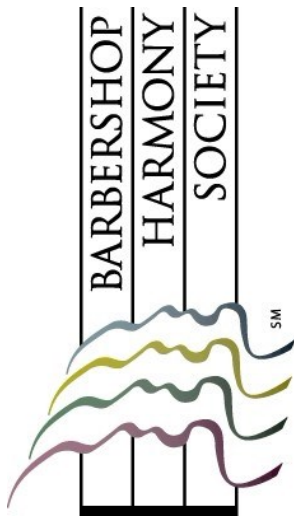

And, apart from working on it towards getting a polecat pin, it's a good idea to learn it (and the other polecats) because they are universally known by Barbershoppers and it's great fun to sing them with other Barbershoppers if you attend contests, etc.

I want to remind you, too, that, to earn credit, you cannot use the sheet music when you are auditioning, and you need to sing the correct notes and lyrics.

Next month (beginning October 2nd) we will start working on "My Wild Irish Rose". Check the list on the table to see what songs you need credit for. And, by the way, I'm not sure the records I've been given are 100% accurate in terms of who has passed which songs; so, if there is a discrepancy between what is shown on the sheet and what you think you've already passed, please see me and we'll see what we can do to iron it out.
